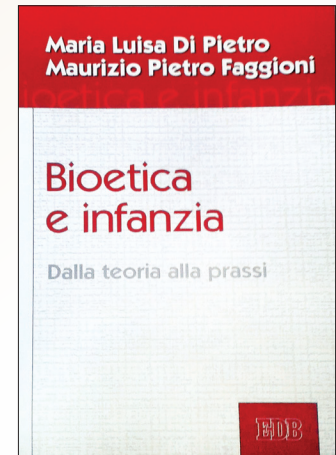

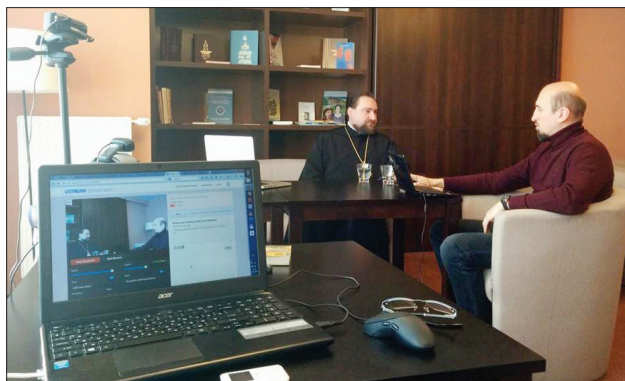


Religious Information Service of Ukraine: Handbook on Religion for Journalists



The multilingual website at www.risu.org.ua is the main focus of UCU's Religious Information Service of Ukraine (RISU). But UCEF is supporting a very important publishing project of RISU, a handbook on religion for journalists.

The staff of RISU realized the need for such a publication when they saw how many journalists in Ukraine do not correctly use religious terminology or possess even elementary historical knowledge about religion in Ukraine. This often leads to distorted information which can lead to misunderstanding and even conflict. The handbook will also help UCU as it prepares a specialty in "religious journalism" for its own School of Journalism.



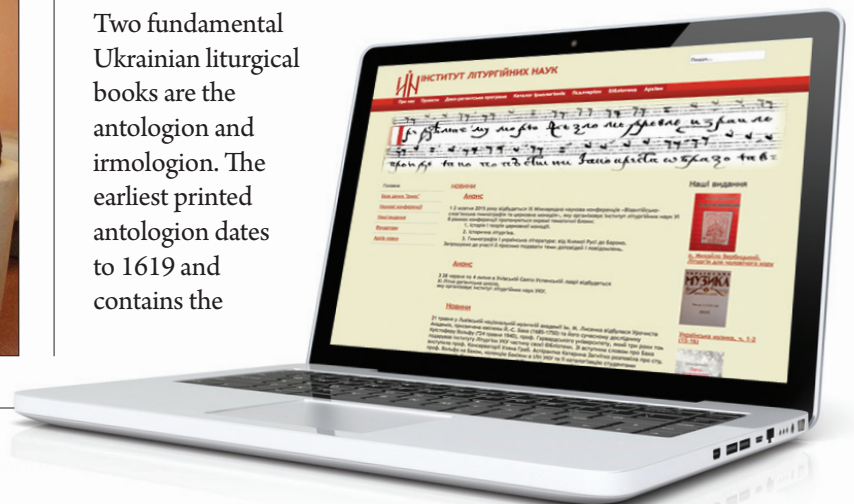
Institute of Liturgical Studies: "Repertoire of Hymnography and Sacred Monody Online."



Though UCU's Institute of Liturgical Studies focuses on time-honored church traditions and texts, the researchers are at the cutting-edge as far as their methods go. UCEF supported the "publishing" project "Repertoire of Hymnography and Sacred Monody Online."

hymnographic texts of the greatest feasts of the church year. The irmologion, the first of which dates back to the second half of the 16th century, is a collection of the most important chants of sacred monody. Ukrainian and also Belarusian repertoire are available.

Two fundamental Ukrainian liturgical books are the antologion and irmologion. The earliest printed antologion dates to 1619 and contains the

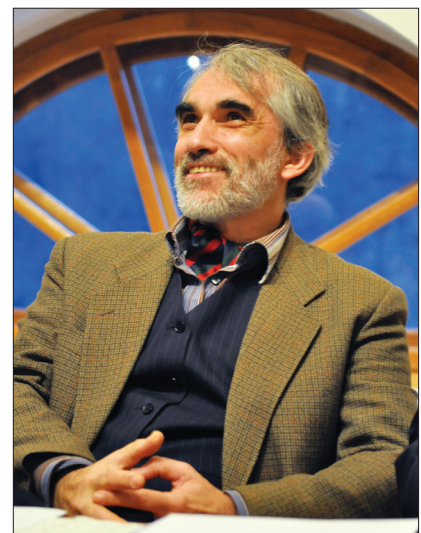

PROF. YAROSLAV HRYCAK, **History of Ukrainian Jews and Ukrainian-Jewish Relations in the Broader Context of Central and East European History**

2014 Activities included:

- Organized regular monthly seminar in Jewish studies, with the participation of scholars from Israel, Ukraine, and countries of the EU
- Developed eight courses, including “Jewish-Ukrainian Relations in the 19th-20th centuries with a special focus on Galicia”
- Taught three courses
- Two dissertations that he supervised on Jews in Galicia were completed
- Started a joint doctoral program in Jewish studies with Jagiellonian University in Krakow, Poland
- Started discussions with the University of Haifa, Israel, on opening a joint Master’s Program in the history of the Jews of Galicia
- A director of the Rothschild Foundation visited UCU and the foundation intends to select UCU as a hub for the development of Jewish studies in all western and central Ukraine

Other Projects

Decorating the Chapel of the Faculty of Theology and Philosophy

Thanks to your donations, UCU was able to provide more furnishings for the chapel in its Faculty of Theology and Philosophy. As Fr. Yuriy Sakvuk, PhD, head of the Pastoral Department, explains:

"The chapel is the spiritual center of the faculty. This is where faith is experienced in personal contact with God. It's a place of prayer and spiritual reflection, where seminarians and theology students have the opportunity to realize the theoretical bases of biblical, liturgical and moral theology... In addition, on these premises are located UCU's Journalism School, the L'Arche community, and the Iconography School. The presence of God's word in daily life is also very important for all these organizations. In addition to the UCU community, the university also invites a wider circle to participate in UCU's liturgical life."



English Summer School

Over 100 students took part in UCU's 2014 English Summer School. This included 16 volunteers from Canada, Australia, Britain and the US. Immersed in English (though in rural Ukraine!) the second-year students

followed one rule: "only English." And even though Sunday was officially their "day of rest" from the foreign language, one of the students reported that sometimes they forgot and communicated in English, anyway.

The school's program consisted of both instruction and relaxation. Daily the students had lessons in small groups, Bible study, and vocabulary development classes. They also had Divine Liturgy and prayer services daily in English. In the evening they played sports, held dances and campfires, watched films, and in various ways used leisure activities to improve their English skills. On the weekends they made visits to old churches in the district. At the end, the students took an exam, after which they put on a talent show and had a dance contest.

Canada and the Ukrainian Catholic University

Canadians at UCU

- UCU has joined with **several Canadian universities** to examine the effects and events of the protests on Kyiv's Independence Square (Maidan) in 2013 and 2014. Among UCU's specific topics are "the Maidan and Religion" and "Women's faces on the Maidan." - The **Canada-Ukraine Alliance for Deaf & Hard of Hearing Persons** and UCU's Social Pedagogy Department organized an educational and recreational summer camp for deaf children.
- In an article in Canada's "Catholic Register," **Jason Kenney**, Canada's Minister of National Defence and Minister for Multiculturalism, suggests Catholics "consider supporting one of the single most important institutions in civil society

in Ukraine, which is the Catholic University of Ukraine [UCU]. I think that is one of the best things that people can do." Kenney visited UCU in 2013.

- The Catholic Near East Welfare Association of Canada received a large grant from the federal **Office for Religious Freedom** to combat religious persecution in parts of Ukraine. CNEWA will work through Ukrainian partners, including UCU.

Healing Psychological Wounds

“Not all wounds are visible,” notes Dr. Oleh Romanchuk, director of UCU’s new Institute of Mental Health. Many were traumatized during the protests in Kyiv’s Independence Square in late 2013 and early 2014. So the university stepped in to help as it was able. The institute is now also working to help soldiers who are serving in eastern Ukraine’s combat zones and others suffering from the conflict.



Good Governance Program



On the eve of his election, President Petro Poroshenko visited UCU and spoke before students of the university’s new “Good Governance” program, which was established to respond to the current needs for leadership training in Ukraine. It aims to develop a new type of manager who is analytical,

knows how to introduce and implement changes during crisis conditions, and practices ethical principles and values. In addition, the program is focused on the formation of a community of graduates with appropriate knowledge and worldview who, in supporting one another, can make changes in society that are noticeable and effective.
